I. The Origin of the Law – Exodus 19-20

It was given to the Israelites orally by God while they were camped at Mount Sinai. God promised that they will be a peculiar treasure, a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation based upon their obedience to the covenant (cf. Exodus 19:4-5; 1 Peter 2:9-10). The people unanimously agreed to do all that they were commanded to do.

The Israelites came to Mount Sinai, camped there for three days, and the Lord was preparing to establish a covenant with His people by means of what we call the "Ten Commandments."

In the morning, on the third day, a trumpet sounded, along with thunders, lightning, and a thick cloud which covered Mount Sinai.

II. The Order of the Law

God begins the Law by stating who He is and what He has done (The strongest argument for obedience is the experience of past deliverance).

A. The Lord is the Supreme Center followed by ones relationship to the family, then relationship to society

- 1. Commandment 1, 2, 3 & 4: Relationship to God
- 2. Commandment 5: Relationship to Family
- 3. Commandment 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10: Relationship to Others

B. Of the Ten, Nine commandments are given in the New Testament either word for word, or with more application for the Christian today

- III. The Object of the Law
  - A. The Law is holy, spiritual, and good Romans 7:12
  - B. The sinner is unable to keep the Law Romans 8:3
  - C. A Schoolmaster that leads us to Christ Galatians 3:24-25
  - D. Fills us with helplessness
  - E. Gives the knowledge of sin (not the knowledge of Christ) Romans 3:19-20
  - F. Opens our eyes and shuts our mouth Romans 3:19
  - G. Leaves us without excuse
  - H. Drives us to Christ
  - I. Not given to provide life Galatians 3:21
  - J. It was given to prepare the way for Christ Galatians 3:23-26



IV. The Obligation to the Law

A. By our faith we establish the Law.

B. Christ has set us free from the Law of sin and death by the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ, in order that we might fulfill the righteousness of the Law.

C. We have been called unto Liberty – Galatians 5:1, & 13

- 1. Liberty is not lawlessness
- 2. Liberty is not license

3. Liberty is fulfilling our destiny to do the will of God - John 14:15 *If ye love me, keep my commandments.* 

4. Love transforms His Law into Liberty – Matthew 11:29-30

D. An outward profession of faith must be supported by an inward practice of a holiness expressed in the Ten Commandments – Galatians 3:12 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.
