## Filling in the Gaps Lesson 27 JESUS CHRIST THE GRAND THEME OF THE BIBLE

In John 5:39 the Lord Jesus Christ says, *Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.* The scriptures testify of Jesus Christ. All of them; start to finish.

**Genesis** - Jesus Christ is the Creator. He is the One that came and covered man's sin in the garden. He is Abel's sacrificial lamb; Noah's ark of safety; Abraham's promised hope; Isaac's substitute so he can live and not die; Jacob's ladder, whose top reaches to heaven; Joseph's deliverer, who brought him out of the prison house and put him on the throne. Praise the Lord! The book of Genesis is about Jesus Christ.

**Exodus** - Jesus Christ is the Passover lamb. He is the One that takes people out of bondage and carries them to a promised land; the One that parts the Red Sea and gets every enemy out of the way. He is the law giver, and then He is the mercy seat above the law for those who cannot keep it. He is the cleansing water in the laver, the light on the candlestick, and the shewbread on the table.

**Leviticus** - He is the supreme sacrifice foreshadowed in all other offerings. He is the great high priest who intercedes between God and His people. He is the shedder of the life giving blood; He is the sin offering. He is the substitute. He is the scapegoat. He is both the bird put to death and the bird that flies alive and free.

**Numbers** - Jesus Christ is a pillar of cloud to guide you in the daytime, and a pillar of fire to guide you in the nighttime. All you have to do is follow Him, and He will get you to the desired haven. He is the center of the camp. He is the serpent on the pole. If you are bitten and dying, all you must do is look to Him, and you can live. He is the star out of Jacob, who will arise to govern the entire earth.

**Deuteronomy** - Christ is the manna falling from heaven to meet your every need. He is the water from the rock to satisfy you in a desert place. He is Aaron's budding rod – life from the dead. He is the object of Miriam's song. If you have sinned and did not even know it, He is the city of refuge where you may flee and escape death. He is the Author of the law and the only One who ever kept it.

**Joshua** - He is the captain of the host. He is the One that makes the enemy's walls fall down. He is the giver of the land. He is the revealer of



secrets, and He has a portion for you. He is the merciful Savior of the fallen woman and the righteous judge of those who trouble His congregation.

**Judges** - He is the One that redeems sinful man out of all his trouble. Whether the need is an ox goad or a jawbone, a tumbling cake or a fiery fox tail, He will bring deliverance. He is the source of help in the most unlikely ways and from the most unlikely sources. That is the Lord Jesus Christ.

**Ruth** - He is the One that finds an outcast girl from a cursed land, who has no hope and nowhere to go. He brings her to the house of bread, watches her labor and toil in the field, falls in love with her, and makes her His chosen bride as she goes from being a lonely girl of a cursed people to being the wife of the richest man in the world. Praise the Lord, that is Jesus Christ.

**1 Samuel** - He is the One that opens Hannah's barren womb. He is the One that conquers David's giant. He is the Shepherd who becomes the King. He is the One who preserves His persecuted ones. When everyone is out to destroy them, He keeps them, preserves them, provides for them.

**2 Samuel** - He is the One that conquers all His enemies and establishes his throne at Jerusalem. Nobody wanted that king on that throne, but He was anointed to sit on that throne – and He did.

**1 Kings** - He is the builder of the temple. He is the One that brings peace to Israel. He is the wise monarch to whom none can compare. He sits upon a great white throne.

**2 Kings** - He is Elijah's chariot of fire. He is Elisha's double portion. He is miracle on top of miracle. He is the meal in the widow's barrow. He is the oil of the widow's cruse. He is the One that can conquer an army without firing a shot. He is the One that can bring enemies into subjection without raising a sword. He is the One who has armies of chariots of fire round about to protect His people when they do not even know they are there. That is Jesus Christ.

**1** Chronicles - He is the One who knows His own by name. He is the greater than Solomon. He is the Ark of the Covenant leading the troops to victory.

**2** Chronicles - He is the one righteous King when all other kings have failed; when all other kings have disappointed. He is the one King you can trust. He is the one King that governs righteously. He is the one King that has no self-interest and no self-will. He does what He does for the good of His people.

**Ezra** - He is the One that brings people back from captivity and gives them a brand-new start. He is the One who righteously chastens those whom He loves and then graciously restores them again.

**Nehemiah** - He is the One that rebuilds the broken walls, rebuilds the fallen temple, rebuilds homes, and rebuilds lives. The Lord rebuilds what enemies had burned to the ground. He is the One who turned the bitter tears



of those who beheld destruction into tears of joy when they saw good days return. That is the Lord Jesus Christ.

**Esther** - He is the One who is never mentioned but is evidently silently ruling in the hearts of men, unnamed and unseen. Haman thinks he is in control. It appears as though a heathen king is in control. Mordecai is not sure if anybody is in control. But Esther just trusted the authority figures in her life and surrendered herself to the will of God. And the Lord moved the pieces around on the chess board until He put the old devil in checkmate, and His people are delivered, and His people are preserved. And there are times in your life you do not see that God is doing anything. There are times in your life when you think it is all enemies and bad news and all trouble; but God is still at work, bringing about His purposes. Praise His holy name.

**Job** - He is strength in suffering. He is hope in despair. He is the one abiding friend when all your other friends have failed to meet the need. He is the One that will turn your captivity and make your latter end better than your beginning.

**Psalms** - He is the One worthy of all praise and all worship. He is the One worthy of every song. He is the One deserving of our adoration. He is short songs and long songs and songs in sorrow and songs in triumph. He is the object of the heart's desire.

**Proverbs** - He is the rule for living. He will tell you how to manage your family, how to manage your emotions, how to manage your mind, and how to manage your finances. He will tell you how to grow your crops and how to harvest your crops. He will tell you with whom to make friends and whom to avoid. If any man lack wisdom, let him ask of God! You will find it in the book about Jesus Christ.

**Ecclesiastes** - He is the best thing under the sun. From youth to old age, you will never find anything better than Jesus Christ. He is the One who frees the life from vanity and despair.

**Song of Solomon** - He is the lover of our soul. He is the one great longing that will satisfy your heart. He is the pure satisfaction for every God-given emotion. He is the One to whom you may safely reveal your secrets and in whose arms you may confidently rest.

**Isaiah** - He is the Holy One. High and lifted up, his train fills the temple. He is Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace. He is the son that is given; He is the child that is born of a virgin. He is the Lord proclaimed by a forerunner. He is the light to the Gentiles. He is the One wounded and bruised beyond recognition, and He is the lamb led to the slaughter to take away our sins. Then He is the risen ruler of all the earth because of his triumph at Calvary.



**Jeremiah** - He is the weeping prophet, the One who repeatedly pleads with the erring ones to turn from their destructive ways. He is the One who chooses to walk into sorrow with and suffer with those who need His abiding presence.

**Lamentations** - We behold Him brokenhearted over sin and its ruin. He is the One whose great faithfulness gets us through every trial and every hardship. He is the One whose mercies are new every morning.

**Ezekiel** - He is the One adorned by the cherubim, scorned by men but ruling in glory and setting up a kingdom that endures 1000 years and beyond.

**Daniel** - He is the stone made without hands, crushing all human government and taking over the world. He is the son of God walking in the fire. He is the One that shuts the lion's mouths. He is the One who writes upon the wall and tells the party crowd their days are numbered. He is the one who sees the beast and all his power and proclaims Himself the eventual conqueror of all principality and power.

Habakkuk - He is the answer when there is no answer.


**Zephaniah** - He is the One who sees the end from the beginning and is not worried about a thing.

**Revelation -** Chapter twenty-one: He is the light in the temple of the New Jerusalem.


**Revelation -** Chapter twenty-two: He is the all in all. Praise the Holy name of Jesus Christ.
