## Names & Titles of Jesus Lesson 1 The last Adam

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This will be a very lengthy series of studies on all the names & titles given to our Lord Jesus Christ throughout the pages of the Bible.

Turn to 1 Corinthians 15... verse 45. Jesus is called in the word of God... Adam. (Not the second Adam... but the last Adam.) And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. 46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual. 47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven. The first man Adam was made, he was not God; Adam was made a created being, formed by God out of the dust of the ground. The Bible says in Genesis God breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and that man made by God became a living soul. The first man Adam was made a living soul. The Bible says, the last Adam... not the second, not the next, but the last Adam. The last Adam was made a guickening spirit. People misread the Bible; they say Jesus is the only son to whom God gave birth. That is not true. Everybody that is saved is a son to whom God gave birth. **Begotten** is an exalted position granted or given above all others... The Bible calls Isaac as Abraham's only begotten son. Hebrews 11:17, He is not the only son born of Abraham's seed. But out of all the sons of Abraham he is the one chosen to inherit the blessing of the land. Isaac received the patriarchal birthright. He is called the only begotten son.

God the Father made the Lord Jesus Christ a quickening spirit. Just as Adam was given power by God to reproduce what he was in a physical being with physical life. Jesus Christ was given power by His power to reproduce what He is a spiritual being with spiritual life living in a body of human flesh.

Believe it or not with all of the arguments going on in both the church and in the world, everybody belongs to one of two families. You have Adam for your father or you have Christ for your father. You are either in Adam or you are in Christ. You have had one birth or you have had two births.

Here is the proof that we came from Adam; The Bible says in Romans chapter 5 and verse 12... *Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:* If sin came into the world by Adam and everyone has received sin because Adam sinned, then it is self-evident that everyone in the world descended from Adam. What we all inherited from Adam was sin. The proof that you are a member of the human race is not your DNA. It is that you are going to die – that is the proof you came from Adam. Look – you can argue with the Bible all you want. Until you meet somebody that does not sin (from birth)... and until you meet somebody who has not been dead three days, the Bible stands! There is no

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science in the world can refute those facts! Everybody on this earth shows selfinterested, self-loving, self-serving and everybody leaves this world by dying. The verse goes on to say... verse 13. (For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law. 14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come. Everybody sins though everybody does not commit the same sin. I am not a sinner because I ate fruit off a tree in a garden. I am a sinner because whatever it is God told me to do, I did not do it! Everybody shows themselves to have inherited Adam's inclination toward yielding to sin; they prove it every single day of their lives by sinning. The blessing is we have in this verse 14 a promise that someone is going to show up whom Adam prefigured; that would start of a brand new order of beings.

In Psalms 51:4-5. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. 5 Behold, <u>I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me</u>. The Bible says in Hebrews 13:4... Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled....The Bible says that God made the man and the woman and put them together in the garden and said be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth. Genesis 1:28. The Bible says in First Corinthians 7:4 that the body of the woman belongs to her husband and the body of the man belongs to the wife. In Psalms 51 the Bible is not saying what my mother and father did was sinful. He is saying from the very moment I was conceived DNA and Adam's sin – that was part of the package.

If you believe the Bible that Adam was the first father... then everybody you see came from Adam. All different origins of all different races, all came from Adam. Acts 17... verse 24. God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; 25 Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things; 26 And hath made of <u>one blood all nations of men</u> for to dwell <u>on all the face of the earth</u>.... If we all have one blood, despite what we look like, then we all came from one man.

Jesus Christ did not replace Adam. Jesus came along in addition to Adam to be the superior one to Adam. The last Adam can give you a birth that is greater than the birth you received from the first Adam. Romans 5:14-15 *Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.* How is Adam the figure of him that was to come? Adam gave birth to a corruptible dead race. Verse 15 *But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.* The last Adam gave birth to an incorruptible living race. 1 Peter 1:23.

You are still going to die because you came from Adam. But you are still going to live because you came from Jesus Christ. The death I receive from Adam continues to

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work in my members until eventually this body dies. If I had never been born again, that death is eternal. If I am born again the last Adam steps in and says, he is mine, He raises us from the dead to enjoy eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Let us compare the generations of Adam to the generation of Jesus Christ Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. Verse 27. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female *created he them.* The reference is a living Trinity; not to what God looks like physically because both the male and female are created in the image of God. Genesis 1:28. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: Genesis 5. Man and the woman were made in the image of God. God is a Trinity... God is alive. He made a man – spirit, soul, body. 1 Thessalonians 5:23 He is alive. But look what happens after he eats that fruit. God told Adam... for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die; Genesis 2:17. Look at Genesis 5:1-31. This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; 2 Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created. Now watch. Verse 3. And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after HIS image; and called his name *Seth:* Something happened. Adam's offspring are not born in God's likeness. They are born in Adam's likeness. They're not born with the image of God; they are born with the image of Adam because they're a triune being but the soul is dead in trespasses and sins and must be regenerated... they must have a new birth. Watch in the book of the generation of Adam. Verse 4 says... And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters: 5 And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died. 6 And Seth lived an hundred and five *vears....* Verse 8. ...and he died. 9 And Enos lived ninety years, and begat Cainan: Verse 11. ...and he died. 12 And Cainan lived seventy years, and begat Mahalaleel: Verse 14. ... and he died. You read that whole chapter in Adam, all die. And he died... and he died... and he died... and he died... and he died. Turn to Matthew. There is only one other book of generations in all the word of God. There are other genealogies - but there are only two books Genesis and Matthew. Matthew chapter 1. Verse 1. The book of the generation of Jesus Christ.... Old Testament – Adam. New Testament – in Christ. You are in one or the other. I am so glad I have had a second birth. Let me show you why. Verse 1. The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. 2 Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren; 3 And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram; 4 And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat Naasson; and Naasson begat Salmon; 5 And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse; Look at what the difference is between Genesis and Matthew, nobody in the book of the generations of Jesus Christ dies. The Holy Spirit who inspired the word of God knew



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how this should have been written from the very start of the Old Testament and the New Testament to show you what He is going to teach you in the gospels and the epistles of the New Testament. If you have a first birth, it is from Adam. You are born in sin. You are born in trespasses and you are going to die and there is nothing you can do to stop that. There is nothing you can do to reverse that. But if you will receive a second birth from the Lord Jesus Christ, you can get a life for your soul that never dies... Hallelujah! What a blessing!
