 ${f I}$ n this lesson the Bible calls Jesus the Bright and Moring Star. He is called the daystar and the dayspring. He is called the Morning star... and all of these connect together. The Bible says in Numbers 24:15-19. And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said: 16 He hath said, which heard the words of God, and knew the knowledge of the most High, which saw the vision of the Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open: 17 I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star (look at the capital "S").. out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. 18 And Edom shall be a possession, Seir also shall be a possession for his enemies; and Israel shall do valiantly. 19 Out of Jacob shall come he that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city. (do not lose that place.) Revelation 22:16-17. I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. 17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come.

When you look at that Revelation passage, we read the 16th verse. Slip right back up into verse 15, *sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie...* The Bible says there is only one for delivering this world from all tears, sorrows, heartaches and disappointments that we know because of sin there is only one **hope** for this world. Jesus said I am the bright and morning star. We have all of this sin in verse 15 and the rising of the bright and morning star in verse 16, and when the Holy Spirit and the Church looks at this outcome it says in verse 17, ... *even so come Lord Jesus.* Stop the murder, stop the lying, stop the broken homes, stop the immorality, come and stop the stealing – *even so come Lord Jesus!*

Back in Numbers there was a king of a very, very wicked people. Evil, Ungodly, filthy people. Just like the United States is today, men and women are ruining their lives looking and doing things that they see on the internet, night after night. Into this country is marching God's chosen people the nation of Israel. They are coming in there with commandments... "Thou shalt not kill... thou shalt not commit adultery... thou shalt not covet thy neighbors wife... thou shalt not bear false witness..." Exodus 20:3-17. There is no way these two

cultures are going to co-exist. The Children of Israel have holy commandments given to them from a holy God, facing a people fully given over to the sins of their flesh.

The king hires one of his fortune teller prophets, his soothsaying preachers and he says I want you to go out for me and curse God's people. If you go out and curse God's people then we will be safe. They will not come in here with all of those commandments and mess up all of our wonderful society of murder, molestation, perversion and kidnapping we do not want them interfering into our affairs and ruining things for us. So that prophet, he goes out stands on a cliff looks down in the valley and sees God's people and try's to curse them when the one true God of heaven begins to overpower his heart and begins to govern his thoughts and he looks upon those people and he realizes they are God's people. They are blessed of God. I cannot curse them. If I bless them I lose my job as the false prophet for the wicked king. But if I curse them... the one true God is liable to snuff me out.

With that in mind... let us read the verses again in Numbers 24:15. Verse 15. Numbers 24:15 And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:16 He hath said, which heard the words of God, and knew the knowledge of the most High, which saw the vision of the Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open:. Do you know what he is doing? He is hoping he can stall long enough, so he does not have to say what he has been told to say by the king. Verse 17. We are half way through the verse before he finally spits it out. ... there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel...? What

there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Sceptre shall rise out of Israel...? What will this Star do when He arrives? Verse 19. ...he that shall have dominion.... He will show up with the power to stop all of the killing, lying, stealing, sin and violence that brings so many tears to our lives. He is the Star with a capital "S" and He is the star rising.

When that prophet saw a Star with a capital S among Jacob, he said that Star is for Isaac. One day that Star shone brightly across the sky as He laid down His life and died for the sins of the whole world and then it seemed after that brief flash of light that darkness and night set in again. The Bible says He is still the Star...rising out of Jacob. One day He is going to burst into that Eastern sky and herald the coming dawn of a brand new day... and when that star rises to fix Himself in the horizon to shine upon this old world, He is going to take dominion. Jesus Christ is coming. He is going to fix this mess.

The Dayspring From On High

The Bible says in Luke 1 (there is a baby born in a manger.) The Bible says in verse 78... Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us, 79 To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow

of death.... Here is dark world a world full of death; and when body that Jesus Christ will occupy is born in that manger in Bethlehem the Holy Spirit of God puts into the heart of these people to pronounce the dayspring from on high has come and light has come into the world. This could be the day we have been looking for and hoping for. Let us read the context and the passage around it.

Luke 1:74 That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, 75 In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life. 76 And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways; 77 To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins, 78 Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us.... This baby is coming to bring in

- Holiness
- Righteousness
- This baby will grow up to take away the sins of the whole world, to offer peace on earth.

When the people of Jesus' time see this great thing they begin to reach for it, only to hear the Lord say not with those sins in your hands, you must repent There is many a man/woman today in this city that when they were offered the home in heaven, eternal life a full and free pardon that Jesus can give them, they begin to reach His way until they hear that Jesus is holy and they have to repent from their sins they go out another way with their head hung low and say, "Well, I don't' know about that... that's not quite what I was looking for..." See also Job 38:12.

The Day Star

Look at Second Peter 1: 19. end of the verse. ...until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: There is a daystar. Some African tribes call it Jumper. At four o'clock in the morning...its dark... it's cold... strange scary sounds of the night. Then about 5:00 AM, it seems like just out of nowhere... a star just shoots right up on the horizon in the eastern sky. It is the day star. It is the morning star. They call it Jumper – it just springs up into the sky.

Second Peter 1:17-20. For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. 18 And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount. 19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private

interpretation. The scripture says from one end to the other. It is not a private interpretation.

"Other" Stars

Psalms 89: 6-8... For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD? 7 God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him. 8 O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee? The reason God forbade and was so offended by men worshipping the sun, the moon, and the stars is they are not God. They are just pictures for us of the Son of God. We saw in our last lesson He is the Bridegroom who comes forth and lightens this world like the light when it comes up in the morning. We see in this lesson that He is the daystar jumping up in the middle of the night and saying in the midst of all this darkness, there is hope in me. The Bible says in Psalms 89 says there is no one to compare to our God. I do not want a shooting star that is here today and gone tomorrow, that makes me happy for a few seconds and then in gone. I want that star that is going to rise my entire lifetime, to lead me and guide me through this dark world and on my very death bed I can look to him in my last hours and know the great day is just on the other side of the rising of this bright morning star.

Who Gets the Morning Star?

Revelation 2: 28... And I will give him the morning star.... Who gets this morning star? Look at verse 18. And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write.... Verse 20. Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols. Verse 23. I try the reins and hearts.... Verse 27. And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. 28 And I will give him the morning star.

Every time we read about this light that shines in the darkness, it is necessary for Him to destroy the source of the darkness in order for you to enjoy the light. There is this seducing spirit – the spirit of Jezebel that is encouraging people to commit fornication and sin against God. Jesus said I will take a rod of iron and smash it like you would smash a piece of pottery. Then the morning star can be yours. In order to have light, we have to away with the darkness. We cannot put Jesus on a dimmer switch. If you ever want to grow in the Lord you have to take all of what Jesus has to offer and allow Him to rid your life completely of the darkness.
