THE AMEN

Revelation 3:14. And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, (capital "A") the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; Remember what we said in a previous lesson about the capitalization of letters in a sentence. (It is the title or a name The Lord Jesus Christ is the faithful and true witness. He is the beginning of the creation of God – those are not capitalized, why? Because the Holy Spirit is speaking of His (Jesus Christ) attributes. In this verse the name of the one who is being spoken of (The Lord Jesus Christ) is the Amen.

Second Corinthians 1:19-20 For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us, even by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea. 20 For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us. Let us see why Jesus Christ is called the Amen. What he affirms is true; what he promises or threatens is certain. Jesus Christ himself is characterized by sincerity and truth He can look with approval only on the same thing in others: and hence He looks with displeasure on the lukewarmness which, from its very nature is hypocrisy. Jesus is the way, the truth and the life, truth, and faithfulness are a part of His very being.

Jesus is the Amen in all His offices. He is a Priest to pardon and cleanse, He is the Amen King to rule and reign for His people, and to defend them with His mighty arm, He is a Prophet of old, to foretell good things to come; He is Amen as to His righteousness. He is Amen in every single title which He bears; Your Husband, never seeking a divorce; your Friend, sticking closer than a brother; Proverbs 18:24. Your Shepherd, with you to lead you through the pathways of life and then into death's dark valley; Psalms 23:4. Your shield and the horn of your salvation, your high tower, your refuge, your deliverer 2 Samuel 22:3, your confidence, Job 31:24, your joy Psalms 16:11, and your Amen in all.

THE ANCIENT OF DAYS

Jesus Christ is also the Ancient of days. - He has lived long enough to know where every religion in the world leads those that follow it.
- He has lived long enough to know what to tell a man and a woman about being husband and wife.

Just think of it. You could get married today and have these instructions offered you from the one who knows everything about marriage. You could bring children into the world and have personal consultation with the one who knows everything there is to know about raising children.

We have the tendency to diminish the Lord's rightful place in our life. Do you realize whose words you are reading? Do you realize who wants to be the light to your path and the lamp to your feet? It is the Ancient of days.

Psalms 110:1-3 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. 2 The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies. 3 Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth. The Ancient of days possesses the dew of youth. He is the Ancient of days and He is the beginning. He is as old or older than time itself and He is not aging. It is hard to wrap our minds around that fact. He is still strong enough to meet your need. He is still fast enough to get there on time. His mind is still sharp enough to give you the answers you are looking for. That is our God! The Ancient of days.

The Ancient of days wants to teach you how to live. Why would you trade that for some nonsense the world's turning out? Hebrews 1:10-12. *And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation*

Hebrews 1:10-12. And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment; And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail. If you could carbon date God a billion years from now His age would be zero, because He has no beginning and no end, He is the beginning and the end He lives outside the bounds of time. Isaiah 45:5-7. I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me: That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else. I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

Revelation 1:7. Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
