Names & Titles of Jesus Lesson 16B – The Christ (part 2)

We are studying the names given by God to His dear Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. In this lesson we will continue on what the Bible says about Christ. Christ is a title given to the man whose name is Jesus. The name Jesus was given to the man who has from everlasting to everlasting been the Lord... the Lord Jesus Christ.

- Christ is used 532 times in scripture.
- Combined with the name, Jesus Christ is used 189 times.
- Flipped, Christ Jesus...58 times.
- Then the full designation... Lord Jesus Christ, 82 times.
- The name Jesus is found 942 times in the New Testament.

Last Lesson

- We saw that the baby who was born in the manger was called Christ. His name was Jesus which is called Christ.
- We saw that Christ (according to John 1) is the Old Testament Messiah.
- Then we went to Daniel 9 and saw that Messiah is the one who would finish the transgression... who would put an end to sin... who would reconcile sinful man to a holy God by bringing in everlasting righteousness.
- Then we saw that Christ (Jesus who is called Christ) is the Lord. This is God reconciling man to Himself in the person of His Son Jesus Christ. Luke 24 says that the only way He could do that was to die in the place of the sinner that the sinner might be eternally in fellowship with God.

Thanks be to God that we as sinners, did not need to get clean, sinless or strong enough to be saved Romans 5:6-8 Many a man has died for a good cause, no one has ever died who could reconcile the sinner to God. Christ died for the ungodly.

Romans 6:1-9 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? 3 Know ve not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were *baptized into his death?* If you get in water, you are in water. If you get in Jesus Christ, you are in Jesus Christ. You cannot stay in the water, but you will always stay in Jesus Christ. (no one can ever take you out. John 10:28) 4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. 8. with him: 9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. Not only did Christ die for our sins, Christ rose from the dead that we might be reconciled to God and Christ lives forever so that we are reconciled to God we will never be separated from God.

Christ died... Christ was buried... Christ rose from the dead. The Bible says in Acts 2:30-32, 36... Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; 31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. 32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. verse 36... Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Jesus the man, Christ the title, Messiah the Saviour, sin bearer, reconciler, died upon the cross, rose from the dead, ascended to heaven, then sat down at the right hand of the Father verse 36, God said I have made Jesus... Lord and Christ. See the wording? God the Father points to the man who ascended and said I have made this man (my Son)... this man I have made Him Christ.

Remember Daniel 9 where we were in the last lesson... *Messiah*. John 1:41 says *Messiah is Christ*. Messiah will finish the transgression and make an end of sin. Messiah will reconcile the people to God. When God the Father pointed to His Son and said, I declare Him to be Christ, He meant If you're not reconciled to God by Jesus Christ you cannot be reconciled to God. (Acts 4:12) If your sins are not brought to an end by Jesus Christ there is nobody out there who can make an end to your sins. (John 14:6)

THREE THINGS THAT BELONG TO CHRIST

1. The Saved Belong to Christ

Romans 16:7-8. Romans 16:7 Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were <u>in</u> <u>Christ</u> before me.8 Greet Amplias my beloved in the Lord. 9 Salute Urbane, our helper <u>in Christ</u>, and Stachys my beloved.10 Salute Apelles approved <u>in Christ</u>. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' household. Notice the saved belong to Christ. If you are saved you belong to Jesus Christ.

2. <u>The Churches Belong to Christ</u>

Romans 16:16. *Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you.* **The** Church of Christ is a much more biblical name than Baptist, it is too bad that their doctrine does not believe in their title - they do not trust Christ. They trust their water baptism.

We are not trying to talk down to anybody. We are just making sure we all understand the Bible as it is written.

3. <u>The Body Belongs to Christ</u>

1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:27 *Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.* The saved who belong to Christ assemble in churches who belong to Christ – but all the saved in all the churches form a body. That body belongs to Christ.

You belong to Jesus Christ. When He saved you He put you in an assembly of believers. He told you to be in an assembly of believers. He made you a part of a body joined one to another. He said I am the one telling you to participate... how, where and when to participate. We are supposed to read the Bible to find out what Christ says since we belong to Him, we do what He says.

Summary

Our lessons do not give us the opportunity to cover all 532 references of Christ in the New Testament, here are a few.

- ✓ He is born Jesus. He is called Christ.
- ✓ Christ in the New Testament means Messiah in the Old Testament.
- ✓ Messiah in the Old Testament is the one who makes an end of sins, reconciles man to God and brings in everlasting righteousness.
- ✓ The one who was born in manger and called Jesus, the heavenly host announced He is Christ.
- ✓ It was foretold in the scripture that Christ would suffer, be buried, rise again three days after His death.
- ✓ The Bible says that Christ did just that for ungodly sinners.
- ✓ The Bible says that any ungodly sinner who will trust Him can be reconciled to God... because Jesus rose from the dead ascended to the right hand of the Father and dies no more if you belong to Him, His righteousness assures you that you will rise from the dead and spend eternity with the Father.

We are not called to preach to goodness in the life of Jesus, though we tell them what He was. We are not called to preach the good deeds or miracles of Jesus though they were wonderful. We preach to the world the gospel of Christ that He died... He was buried... He rose again... He is the only one who can take away your sins and reconcile you to God. We rejoice in knowing that Christ's righteousness belongs to all who believe on Him so that we get

to heaven on His merits because we could never get to heaven on our own merit. Everyone who has trusted Christ as His Saviour belongs to Him, the churches in which they assemble belong to Him, the body of Christ as a whole belongs to Him. It is the body of Christ, the church of Christ made up of Christ-ones (Christians). Praise the Lord.

Again what we said in the previous lesson, the holy title of Jesus Christ should never be a curse word or an oath on the lips of any living human being. If you are going to use that name, use it with reverence an honour. For the Lord Jesus Christ alone is worthy of all praise, honour, and glory.
