Genesis 3 Lesson 14 The nature of the woman

Those who teach there are no differences between men and women are unknowing destroying society, and the human race. The truths of this lesson and the next are in no way an insult to the female but sound Biblical instruction to help her overcome the world, the flesh and the Devil.

There are certain characteristics of the female that mark her as distinct from the male. If you have bought into this nonsense that they have been teaching in America since the early 1960's there is no difference between male and female, it saddens me. We pray that you will keep an open mind while doing these lessons.

If you would like to know why so many women are seeing shrinks, taking pills and having nervous breakdowns, this is why. Someone has lied convincing them the man's place is their place... the man's role is their role; poor women in our society are living their entire lives trying to be something God never intended them to be.

When we teach these things, we are not in any way shape or form trying to put a woman in her place. We are trying to show you what God said the woman's place is. God will leave it up to you if you are a woman to put yourself in that place or be miserable.

A woman has no higher privileges in nations where the word of God is the foundation. You can say what you want about this Bible being chauvinistic and anti-woman, but where this Bible sets the standards a woman is treated better than she is anywhere else on the face of this earth. God wrote the Bible to help the woman to avoid the snares and pitfalls into which the devil would have her to fail.

Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, (Notice – not to the man.) ...he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? 2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: 3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, (God never said that.) lest ye die. 4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: 5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. 6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

This incident takes place in the garden, we can learn some things about Adam that are true of every man, we can learn some things about Mrs. Adam (the name Eve was not assigned to Mrs. Adam till after the fall) You often hear women say, *"I'll be an independent woman ... I'll keep my own name."* However it is not your name... it is your father's name. The woman is not going to get around the way God set it up. There are three things we learn about Mrs. Adam that are true of every one of her female descendants. Satan knew these things and Satan used them to get advantage over her and conquer her.

1. Curiosity - Because she was not present with Adam at the beginning of the race, the woman naturally feels she has missed out on something and wants to know all. Eve was not there when Adam named all those animals. Eve was not there when God spoke to Adam and gave him those instructions. There is something in Eve that just wants to know, to find out, she does not want to miss out; she wants to get all the details. The grocery store tabloids, ongoing soap opera plots and the tendency to gossip, are all innate manifestations of this nature Micah 7:5.

Ladies, listen closely, that devil will eat you alive if you do not understand that curiosity is part of your nature. The devil gets an advantage over you by your curiosity, that longing to know to find out all the details. You need to understand that this is a weak point in your life where Satan will use to hurt you.

Micah 7:5 *Trust ye not in a friend, put ye not confidence in a guide: keep the doors of thy mouth from her that lieth in thy bosom.* Ladies... You may think that you want to know about every girl he ever kissed. But it is better that you do not. Satan is playing upon your weakness... your curiosity feeling that somehow I am missing out on something and if you had the details it would just be something more for him to torment, oppress, and persecute you with. The Bible's advice in Micah 7:5 is the same advice in Philippians 3:13-14 *... forgetting those things which are behind, and pressing toward the mark.*

2. Feeling of being kept under - The woman has a natural resentment toward her God given place of submission. Her bitterness is seen in her words of Genesis 3:3. By adding neither shall ye touch it to what God commanded she manifests her resentment at being told what to do. The serpent said, "What did God tell you?" Eve said, *"He said we couldn't eat... don't even TOUCH it..."* He did not say that. Why did she add the additional phrase? Because she felt like she was not getting her due. She felt like somehow... someway she was being kept back from the best part.

Now, Satan will come at you and he'll say, *"You have heard all that talk about the man being the head of the household... you know what that*

is, this is just God trying to keep you under... why you are just as good as that man..." Hey! You might be ten times better than that man. If you are better, prove it by cheerfully taking your place instead of getting out of your place and sinning against God.

In most of the churches today women outnumber the men. Do you know why? Because growing up in Church, the women were in charge of the Sunday school programs, this convinced young boys that church is for women. Those women thought they helping taking a leadership positions. They did not understand since that was not given them by God they were driving their sons and your grandson's right out of the house of God. God said: *Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.* James 4:10 It is better to be exalted by God than exalt self.

Gentlemen, when God created Mrs. Adam, he took one of Adam's ribs, showing us that the woman is to be by the man's side always. God did not take Adam's foot to make Mrs. Adam, so that man would step on her, but from his side signifying that she has an equal role in life. I could not do my ministry work for the Lord, unless my wife kept the house; prepared my clothes, took care of the children, we are a team. In any successful team there must be leadership whether in battle, at work or on the game field, all the team works together to achieve the goal.

Now I know some of you are saying... *"Oh yeah... you think that's all a woman does is cook and clean, NO I do not think that at all.* I am acknowledging however that I could not perform my ministry if she did not perform hers; we work together as a team. If I let her forget that her part of the ministry is just as important as my part, then the whole ministry will suffer and hers will begin to falter. Gentlemen, we need to remind her that whatever she does is always appreciated lest Satan get advantage over her.

3. Trust in emotions - The woman acted on sight Genesis 3:6 because she was beguiled (charmed) 2 Corinthians 11:3 and deceived 2 Timothy 3:6; 1 Peter 3:7. It must be understood that the nature of the female is to act upon how it makes her feel rather than reason. Men make decisions based upon strategy a man will come to conclusion after he has researched every other possible scenario. Wicked men know that women react upon their feeling and emotions so they prey upon that fact. How many women have fallen prey to a man who tells her he loves her. All women should know this and guard against it.

Many men have seen a beautiful woman with an ugly guy and said to themselves – what is she doing with him? That man figured out what to say that would intrigue her making her feel special making her feel like he was the only one for her. He just knew all the right buttons to push. She reacted upon her feelings.

- THE NATURE OF THE WOMAN AS LEARNED IN THE GARDEN

a. Subtle and beguiling in practical matters. The fallen nature of the woman provokes her to plot and scheme to gain what she cannot have by any means. Some examples are:

Rebekkah - Genesis 27

Rahab - Joshua 2

Herodias - Matthew 14

Rebekkah in Genesis 27:1-10. She wanted that birthright for Jacob and she schemed a way for him (Jacob) to receive.

Rahab in Joshua 2:1-4 she hid the spies then lied to the men of the city about where they were.

Herodias - Matthew 14:1-14 she hated John the Baptist and designed a way to get him killed by having her daughter dance for Herod while he was drinking with his friends.

Ladies.... You can figure out a way to run your house, get your husband do what you say, you will only be disobeying the word of God by doing your own thing; but God will never bless it. In the end you will be sorry.

I can tell you numerous stories of women weeping and hurting over how their teenage daughters have turned out. They ask me what can they do, and my response is your daughter learned from you when she was seven, eight and nine years old you taught them to disobey their fathers and the establishment. You taught them how to get around authority by watching you. You showed them how to get around the authority of the word of God. You will never win by disobeying the Bible.

b. Subtle and beguiling is manifest in prostitution. Proverbs 5-7 details the extent to which the serpent took possession of the female character in the garden of Eden affair. Interesting how the character of the modern American woman matches the character the Bible sets forth for as a prostitute. Proverbs 7:6-13 *For at the window of my house I looked through my casement, 7 And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding, 8 Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house, 9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night: 10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.* Her clothing was inappropriate for public place. Ladies, the word attractive if what you are wearing attracts attention to your physical attributes, it is not right.

Verse 11. *She is loud and stubborn; ...her feet abide not in her house: 12 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner. 13 So she caught him, (Look how bold she is.) ...and kissed him, (Look how forward she is.) ...and with an impudent face (Do you know what's wrong with this*

nation? Our little girls cannot blush anymore. They are not embarrassed about anything. The little girls today wear clothing and act as though they are performing at a night club. The Bible is describing a harlot, a prostitute. Not a virtuous, God-fearing, heaven-bound Christian woman. We need to be careful about how we are raising our young people; do you want them to grow up with American morals or with Biblical morals?

c. Subtle and beguiling in religious matters. Thus, those deceived by Satan into joining a church which is thoroughly Satanic are said to be duped by the Mother of Harlots (Revelation 17), seduced by Jezebel (Revelation 2:20).

In religious matters, some of the cults in America were started by a woman. Mary Baker Patter Glover Eddy (Christian Science). Mary Ellen White (Seventh Day Adventist). Kathryn Kuhlman (the Charismatic Movement).

That great one world religion of the last days (Revelation 17) is called Mystery Babylon, Mother of Harlots. The devil is setting the stage for our world in the last days, almost every denomination in America is ordaining women, it is satanic.

The Mystery of Babylon is not the Roman Catholic Church, but is a system that has been at work since Genesis 3 when the woman tried to exalt herself to the position of authority over the man.

Some women know the Bible better than men, but God never intended them to be the head of a family, church, or government. Most women; read, pray, witness and are more spiritual more than men, but it still does not change the way God set things in order.

Ladies, when the man fell in the garden so did the woman, their natures became corrupt. The lesson was not intended to criticize or condemn the woman. We have tried to point out to you the weaknesses upon which Satan will prey if you let him. Please do not let Satan get an advantage over you. The role God has given you, this is where you will be the happiest; this is where you will enjoy the rich blessings of God.
